Overseen by the SCTE•ISBE Engineering Committee, the program is the only ANSI-accredited standards forum for the cable telecommunications industry.

DVS is seeking operational practices papers, technical papers, and case studies for this next issue of the journal. Proposals are still being accepted until **Friday, March 2** or submit your completed paper by **Monday, March 12**.

Priority topics include:

- Impact of new and emerging video and audio codecs on ad insertion
- HDR adoption and operationalization
- Video quality testing and assurance for Ultra HD, HDR/WCG, and VR content
- Evolving models and technologies to distribute content
- Next-generation security platform and content protection (case studies)
- MPEG-DASH, MPEG-CMAF, and emerging technologies in HTTP live streaming
- Bandwidth-efficient video compression and streaming
