SCTE[®] Announces 2022 Chapter Award Winners

EXTON, Pa. — (April 6, 2023) — <u>The Society of Cable Telecommunications Engineers</u> (SCTE[®]), a <u>Cable Labs</u>[®] subsidiary, announced the winners of its 23rd annual Chapter Awards, which celebrate chapters and enable members to acknowledge excellence among those who contribute substantially to the industry by providing local educational opportunities, certification testing, outreach, membership support, and networking opportunities for cable telecommunications professionals.

The organization's Gateway Chapter (based in St. Louis, MO) was named Chapter of the Year after placing third in 2021. The Gateway Chapter also garnered best overall honors in both Compliance, for the second consecutive year, and Training & Development.

Rounding out the top chapters were Chattahoochee (Atlanta, GA) in second, Piedmont (Charlotte, NC) in third, Great Lakes (Waterford, MI) in fourth, Cactus (Phoenix, AZ) in fifth, and Penn-Ohio (Pittsburgh, PA) in sixth.
