SCTE® Seeks Nominations for Industry Awards to be Presented in Person at SCTE® Cable-Tec Expo® 2023

Deadline for Nominations for Cable Honorees in Eight Categories is July 1

This year, to celebrate a milestone four decades of connections, collaboration and innovation at Expo, the awards will be presented on Wednesday evening, October 18, 2023, starting at 6:00pm MT at the SCTE Awards and 40th Anniversary of Expo Celebration.

- <u>Excellence in Standards Award</u> Honors a SCTE Standards program participant who
 has significantly contributed to both the technical standards program and the spirit of cooperation necessary for the success of voluntary standards.
- <u>International Engineering Professional Award</u> Highlights outstanding technical achievements made by an engineering professional living outside of the United States.
- <u>Member of the Year Award</u> Recognizes the member who has made the most significant contributions to the Society during the past year.
- Wilt J. Hildenbrand Jr. Award Recognizes an industry star who is 40-years-old or younger and making significant contributions in the cable industry.
- Hall of Fame Permanently recognizes active SCTE members who have made extraordinary contributions to the Society and industry.
- <u>Senior Member</u> Honors members who have demonstrated technical competence, participated in the Society and industry affairs, attained a degree of seniority and maintained a high level of professionalism.

Women in Technology Award - Made possible through a joint effort of The WICT Network, SCTE and Cablefax, the annual Women in Technology Award acknowledges the achievements of one woman who has contributed to the advancement of technology in the cable and media industry and demonstrated outstanding personal and professional growth.
